COREPSYCH SPECT Brain Imaging Process

Follow these guidelines to have SPECT Scans at the Amen Clinics, and then follow with an evaluation of scans, medication review and consideration of different interventions by Dr Parker:

Please follow these guidelines to have SPECT Scans sent to us, and then follow with an evaluation of the scans, medication review and consideration of different interventions by Dr. Parker:

1. Dr. Parker is located in Virginia Beach, VA and accepts SPECT images from any SPECT Clinic for the scan portion of the evaluation process. Dr. Parker developed Amen Clinic DC and, has regularly used SPECT imaging evidence to assist with diagnosis and treatment since 2003.
2. All aspects of the scan process are *arranged initially* through our office in Va. Beach, 757.473.3770 ext 203, through our COREPSYCH Patient Care Coordinator.
3. Please sign a Release of Information for that will allow Amen Clinic to send the scans and findings to Dr. Parker at COREPSYCH.
4. Billing and costs are outlined in the following section.
5. Our experienced COREPSYCH Historian will receive your intake forms and will schedule a 1.5 hour interview. [See details next page]
6. After two SPECT scans readings [concentration and baseline], the tomographic scan findings, and scan 3-D renderings, will be sent to Dr. Parker in Va. Beach.
7. We prefer that you see Dr. Parker in the office, but if that's impossible, we will review the findings with you by phone.
8. We will schedule a 1.5 hour review with Dr. Parker. This review and the final evaluation are sent to you hardmail and/or electronically within 2 days.
9. Dr. Parker will make specific recommendations and work with your preselected local medical team, if they agree to participate with his consultation. [Ask us for clarification early if this appears a problem.]
10. Follow-up consultations are schedule in accordance with reasonable practice guidelines, most often depending upon acuity of care. Dr. Parker does not write prescriptions for distant patients who haven't been seen in the office.

How to Schedule a History Appointment

Urgent Action: Once you have received your intake questionnaire, fill out all the necessary paperwork quickly, and include any relevant medical documents (lab results, recent tests, etc.). Completion of these questions will expedite the evaluation process. *This must be completed ASAP – and do send it off right away,* as this is most frequent delay we experience in completing SPECT evaluations.

Once Bethany has received your packet *she will call you* (at the phone number provided on the paperwork) and set up a phone appointment to review the paperwork and go over additional information. Each appointment will take approximately 90 minutes. Following your history appointment, Bethany will generate a report the same day and send it to Dr. Parker.
